

The foreign tax reported on Form 1099-DIV is based on your share of the Fund's foreign taxes paid. The foreign taxes paid are based on the earnings the Fund received from its investments in foreign securities and the taxes the Fund paid to foreign governments at the mutual fund level.

If you received a foreign tax credit from our funds, it will be shown in Box 6 on your Form 1099-DIV. You may claim the foreign tax as an itemized deduction, or you may claim a foreign tax credit (but not both). Please consult your tax advisor for information on how you might be able to use this data when preparing your tax return.
